Q. When should a Joint Supplement be introduced to my horse's ration?

A. Joint health is essential for all horses including young horses, adult or normal mature horses as well as senior and aged horses. The longevity of a horse's riding and competition career is greatly influenced by good nutrition and long-term management of joint health and function. Redi-Flex can be used by horses in regular work to maintain healthy joints and cartilage. Performance horses competing at moderate to high level equestrian sports and racing will benefit from Redi-Flex as a supplement to support day to day concussive joint movements and cartilage 'wear and tear'. Redi-Flex is also a helpful supplement for aged or senior pleasure riding or paddock horses experiencing joint pain, inflammation or arthritis.

Q. Is Redi-Flex compatible with other Supplements?

A. The Redi-Flex formulation is specifically focused as a complete 'joint food', however, it is not a full 'ration balancing' supplement. It is designed to be fed in conjunction with a balanced diet that meets the daily nutrient needs of a horse or pony. Redi-Flex is compatible with all other Kohnke's Own supplements including Cell-Provide®, Cell-Vital® or Cell-Perform® which are designed as comprehensive ration supplements to be chosen depending on the exercise level of your horse.

Fed at the recommended dose, Redi-Flex provides specific levels of certain vitamins and trace-minerals as special high potency or organic chelated complexes. Although these nutrients contribute to the total daily intake of your horse, the addition of Redi-Flex will not oversupply nutrients in a normally balanced diet.

Q. Why doesn't Redi-Flex include Chondroitin?

A. Chondroitin sulfate is not included in Redi-Flex because previous published 'GAIT' studies in humans, and also our own controlled field trial conducted with 30 high performance horses, showed that chondroitin may have a negative effect on the action of glucosamine in joint health and function. Also, Redi-Flex does not contain any green-lipped mussel or fish sourced nutrients, which can cause allergies in horses as well as being very unpalatable.

Q. How long before I see results?

A. The benefits of supplementation vary between individual horses. Most horse owners noticed return of normal movement, including willingness of movement and general suppleness, within 2-3 weeks. However, in some horses the period of 6-8 weeks of daily supplementation may be required to see full benefits of healthier joints. Our research trials found that in general, horses working at light to moderate levels improved more quickly, as regular movement but not high impact joint concussion enables the nutrients targeting the joints to be renewed and perfuse the joint and cartilage structures for visible benefits to movement and function.

Q. Which dose rate should I choose?

A. Horses (450 – 600 kg body weight) are recommended to start Redi-Flex supplementation at the loading dose of 40 grams (1 level scoopful) once daily. This dose rate may be continued as required in high performance horses or those experiencing heavy joint concussion. A lower dose rate (20 grams, ½ scoopful daily) may be given after 60 – 90 days as a maintenance supplement for healthy joints and cartilage. The dose rates should be reduced for ponies and horses under 450 kg bodyweight.

Glucosamine

A key nutrient for the production of joint structural components and a necessary part of glycosaminoglycans (GAG) protective matrix surrounding cartilage in joints. Also helps replenish damaged cartilage. Included as the higher potency and more stable form, glucosamine hydrochloride. This is more stable in supplements compared to glucosamine sulfate.

Vitamin C and Vitamin E

Powerful natural anti-inflammatory and antioxidant nutrients with benefits to flexibility, suppleness, collagen health and maintenance of joint tissues. Vitamin C is included as a high potency, protected form for best absorption in horses. Also contains a special high potency RRR-vitamin E, which is more bioactive than normal vitamin E supplements. Combination is more effective than rose hip style supplements which just contain vitamin C.

Organic Copper, Zinc and Manganese

These trace-minerals may modulate joint repair processes and maintain resilience of healthy joints. Copper is essential as part of the matrix metalloproteases, enzymes which help limit inflammation, repair and renew existing cartilage damage. The 'green' in green-lipped mussel supplements is copper, but our formulation is improved with balanced levels of zinc and manganese, which also benefit development of normal, healthy joints in horses.

Organic Sulfur

Sulfur is an essential natural anti-inflammatory molecule and known to be important for protein regeneration to support healthier joint fluid. There are multiple other benefits to cartilage repair processes that are mediated by sulfur-containing molecules. As special high purity MSM source, not to be confused with lower purity forms available in bulk from feed outlets.

Specific Amino Acids

A source of specific amino acids for collagen production and renewal of matrix components within joints, more specific when combined in supplementation with glucosamine, antioxidants and organic sulfur. These include higher natural levels of proline and other essential amino acids for comprehensive joint health.

Organic Silicon

A scientifically proven role in maintaining the resilience of joint cartilage and subchondral bone plus lubrication of joint surfaces.
